If so, the growing Town of Zebulon in desirable Wake County, NC, invites you to apply to be its <u>first</u> Town Engineer. Joining a community with a customeroriented culture, the Town Engineer is responsible for developing and maintaining public infrastructure, including town streets, sidewalks, and stormwater systems. This position is for the professional who has a passion for public service and who thrives under leadership that embraces diverse perspectives and ideas and honors initiative and innovation.

Zebulon's <u>first</u> **Town Engineer** has the unique opportunity to create a high standard of excellence for the Town's engineering efforts and significantly impact the quality of life for Zebulon's residents and visitors. The **Town Engineer** will work on projects from conception to completion and utilize their communication skills to educate, inform, and engage stakeholders throughout the project management process. The ideal candidate for this position is an engineering generalist with broad general engineering knowledge, and the ability to combine ideas from diverse engineering fields and convey them to a general audience. Exposure to transportation and stormwater projects is helpful.

About the Organization and Position:

The Town of Zebulon operates under a Council/Manager form of government. Zebulon's proposed FY 23-24 budget of \$22.3M supports 95 highly skilled staff across seven (7) departments. Zebulon is committed to enhancing the quality of life of its residents by delivering excellent, friendly services and fostering collaboration within the community. With a focus on ensuring that Zebulon grows smart, maintains its small-town life, and has a vibrant downtown, the town's strategic plan provides strategic priorities for the next seven years.

Reporting to the Town Manager, the **Town Engineer** is responsible for planning and directing a variety of engineering projects town-wide, creating and enforcing stormwater regulations, reviewing development plans, and administering engineering contracts. The **Town Engineer** is the point of contact with State and local partners, including NCDOT. The ideal candidate is an impeccable decision-maker who makes thoughtful and strategic decisions.


This highly engaging role is for the professional who embraces a collaborative, team-centric working environment. The **Town Engineer** will work collaboratively with the Public Works Director on MS4 compliance and the Planning Director on plan review while also serving as a vital member of the Town's Technical Review Committee. Demonstrating their highly effective communication skills, the **Town Engineer** must explain complex technical/engineering matters in an understandable way to elected officials, the development community, residents, and staff.

Zebulon's first **Town Engineer** works independently yet enjoys engaging with people to communicate, motivate, and strategically partner to accomplish the town's goals. The Town Manager desires a **Town Engineer** who is an innovator and an excellent problem solver—someone who demonstrates confidence to try new approaches and methods and is adaptable and flexible. As the new engineering department grows in capacity and capability over time, the **Town Engineer** will ultimately oversee staff involved in development and capital projects. Therefore, the ideal candidate can manage and direct staff effectively.

Upon their appointment, the Town Engineer will thoroughly evaluate the needs of the community and prioritize the following tasks:

- Oversee project management for several of the town's capital improvement projects (i.e., stormwater improvements, thoroughfare widening, facility expansions, sidewalk, and traffic light installation); seek and pursue grants and low-interest loans to help fund the town's capital projects.
- Administer the town's Stormwater Management Program (MS4 municipal separate stormwater sewer system) and work closely with the Public Works Department, which handles maintenance of the stormwater management infrastructure.
- Review the town's current development plans to ensure compliance with adopted plans and ordinances, stormwater management, and road design.
- Plan, develop, and implement multimodal transportation for the town to include walking, bicycling, greenways, and bus while ensuring standards and specifications in the Unified Development Ordinance are followed.
- Play an instrumental role in developing the value, scope, and financing of the FY '25 bond referendum and the five-year capital improvement plan.

The successful candidate is a collaborative problem-solver, able to work with a wide variety of internal and external stakeholders with different needs. This individual has experience in the design and/or construction management of various capital projects, with a preference for work in transportation or stormwater. Lastly, the successful candidate is eager to learn and willing to develop new skills in areas outside of their area of expertise and demonstrates a desire to assist other departments with their engineering needs.





Qualifications:

A bachelor's degree in engineering with five years of progressive supervisory and/or project experience *is required*. An equivalent combination of experience and education will be considered. Experience with bidding capital projects in stormwater and transportation *is preferred*. Registration as a Professional Engineer in the State of NC is preferred, but the ability to obtain within a negotiated time frame is acceptable. Zebulon is an Equal Opportunity Employer.

About the Community:

With a population quickly surpassing 10,000, Zebulon is Wake County's easternmost town and is located just 20 miles from North Carolina's Capital City of Raleigh. Zebulon is a charming small town known as "The Town of Friendly People." Residents enjoy a small-town feel while having all the amenities and access to Raleigh's metropolitan area of 1.5 million people. Experiencing similar growth patterns to the region, the town's population grows and diversifies by as many as seven people daily. Current strategic planning and development forecasts estimate that Zebulon's population will nearly double by 2030.

The town is home to the Milwaukee Brewer's single A affiliate Carolina Mudcats and Five County Stadium. Zebulon's premier industries include GlaxoSmithKline, Nomaco, US Foods, and Truist Data Center (formerly BB&T). Zebulon's historic downtown features the award-winning Olde Raleigh Distillery and the world-class MacLellan Bagpipes (the only bagpipe manufacturer in North America).

Wake County and its communities have received national and international rankings and accolades from publications such as Money, Fortune, and Time magazines as one of the best places to live and work. Its world-class healthcare, higher education, public school system (the largest in the state), and variety of entertainment provide ample opportunities for Zebulon's residents. Zebulon is bordered by four counties and boasts easy access to many points of interest, including Raleigh-Durham International Airport and Research Triangle Park. The town is approximately 3 hours from the mountains of North Carolina and 2 hours from Atlantic Coast beaches.

Salary and Benefits:

The salary range for this position is \$93,343 - \$140,015. Starting salary is dependent upon qualifications and experience. Zebulon offers a competitive benefits package, including paid medical, dental, vision, and life insurance, a 5% contribution to 401k, state retirement, 12 paid holidays, and birthday time off.
